**5. New conclusions of the thesis**

### ***5.1. Academic contributions***

The thesis has clarified the theoretical issues regarding public assets and public asset management in public higher education institutions in general and those controlled by the Ministry of Defense in particular. Especially, the thesis has clearly pointed out the specific characteristics of public asset management in higher education institutions directly under the Ministry of National Defense and its impact on the results of state budget expenditure management on public assets. The PhD student has also inherited and supplemented criteria to measure the results of public asset management in higher education institutions controlled by the Ministry of Defense. Based on this background, a theoretical framework has been built as a basis for assessing the current state of public asset management in higher education institutions directly under the Ministry of National Defense.

### ***5.2. Practical contributions***

The thesis has analyzed and clarified the current situation of public asset management in higher education institutions controlled by the Ministry of National Defense in the 2016-2020 period, thereby clearly indicating the limitations and causes of the limitations in public asset management. At the same time, the thesis has surveyed and studied practical experiences in public asset management in military higher education institutions in China, Australia and Canada to propose four practical lessons which can be considered and

applied to improve public asset management in higher education institutions directly under the Ministry of Defense. The thesis has proposed opinions, orientations and solutions and recommendations with scientific and feasible basis to improve the management of public assets in higher education institutions controlled directly by the Ministry of Defense. These solutions and recommendations are useful references for public asset managers in higher education institutions under the Ministry of Defense in particular, and the Ministry of National Defense in general in the management of public assets in accordance with the requirements of the military development.
